She stated that there would be one performance on Tuesday, March 14, 2017 at 7:30pm at East Beach Conference Center. She stated that the venue fee can possibly come out of contingency.

Mrs. Johnson made a motion to add the Columbia City Ballet to the 2016/2017 Arts and Cultural Events Council season at \$19,000. The motion passed unanimously.
