Mr. McCollum withdrew his proposal for Peppino D'Agostino to accommodate violinist Simone Porter.

Mrs. Chitwood stated that Fred Hersch fee will be reduced to \$8100 because the backline cost will be less than she originally thought.

Mrs. Johnson asked the committee to confirm dates that were discussed today with the performers and report back. She stated that the budget is not final until June 7<sup>th</sup> and contracts will be awarded after.
